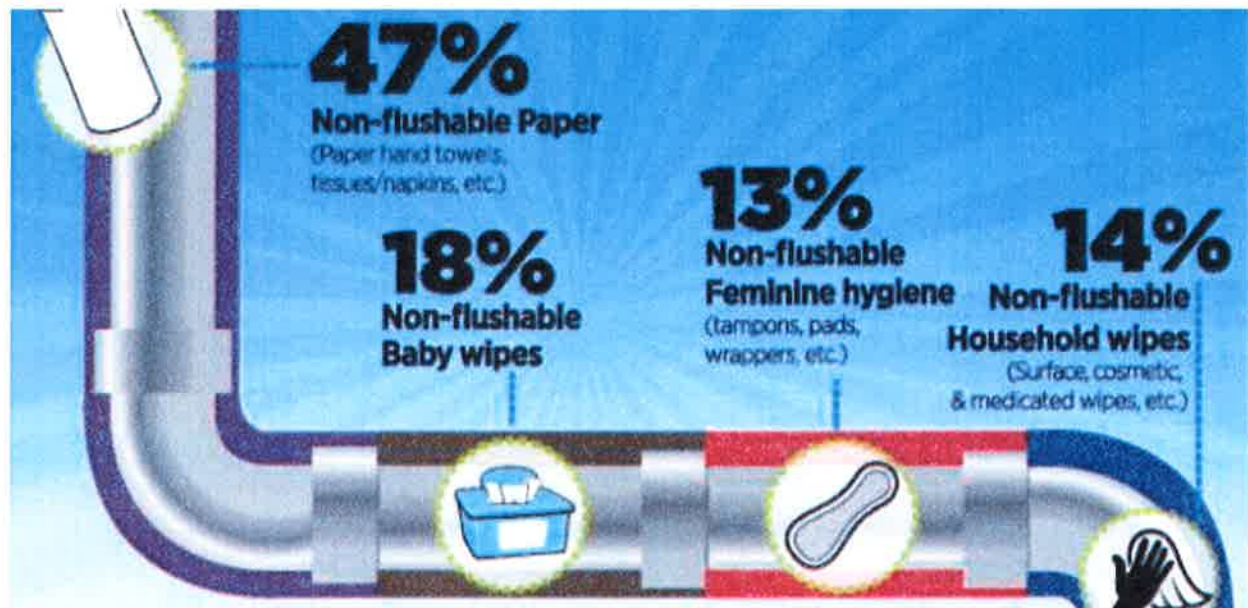




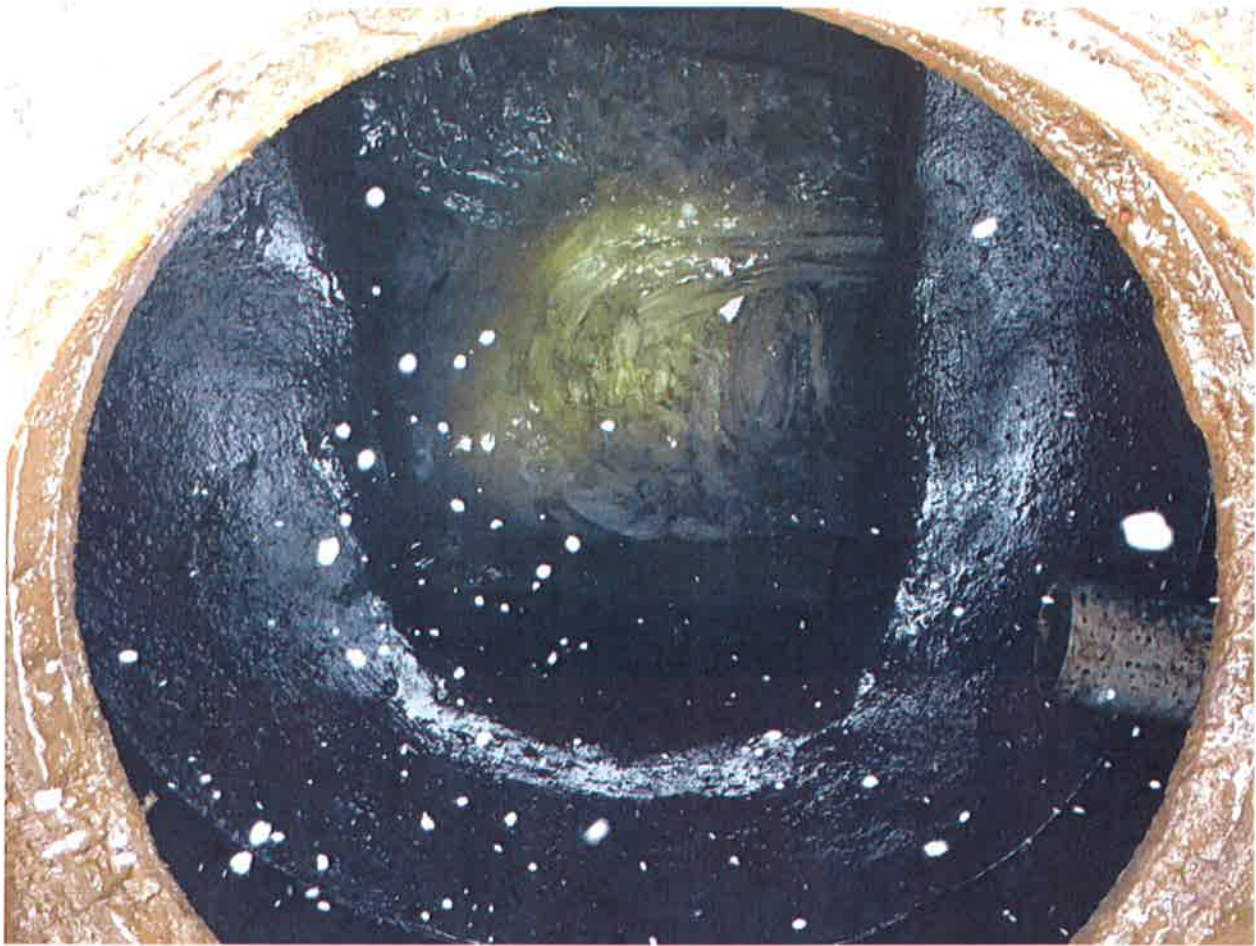

We are having a serious problem with paper products in our sewer. We continue to have issues in the Gad Valley area with paper products becoming stuck in the sewer line. We have to clean up to 100 pounds per week of paper products from our main sewer line. Should the line become completely blocked we run the risk of releasing hazardous contaminants into the environment.

It appears that a majority of the debris is paper towels! Please inform your maintenance and housekeeping staff to NEVER put paper towels in the toilets. We realize that we cannot control what our guests choose to do. For your own information, flushable wipes are NOT flushable. They do not break up and decay like toilet paper does.



This is a view looking down manhole #110 just west of the Creekside lodge. You are looking at a 100 pound blob of debris nearly blocking off 2-12" sewer mainlines. This manhole was cleaned 5 days before this picture was taken.
